## **BEST VALUE**

In accordance with Education Code, 51.9335, in determining what the best value TSTC will consider the following:

1) Purchase price

- 4) The extent to which the goods or services meets the institution's needs
- 5) The vendor's past relationship with the institution
- 6) The impact on the ability of the institution to comply with laws and rules relating to historically underutilized businesses and to the procurement of goods and services from persons with disabilities
- 7) The total long-term cost to the institution of acquiring the vendor's goods and services; and/or

## Invoicing

Original invoices must be submitted in connection with all payments. To be a proper invoice that may be accepted and paid, the invoice must include the following information and/or attachments; Name and address of the vendor, vendor's invoice remittance address, Purchase order number authorizing the services, detailed breakdown of total price of the goods. TSTC is exempt from taxes pursuant to the provisions of the *Texas Tax Code*, Chapter 151. Do not include tax in the Proposal. Excise Tax Exemption Certificates are available upon request.

Each invoice is subject to review and approval by TSTC before payment will be processed. Normal payment processing time for services which have been completed or items that have been delivered to, and approved by TSTC is thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of a valid, uncontested invoice. TSTC will incur no penalty for late payment if payment is made in thirty (30) or fewer days from receipt of goods or services or receipt of an uncontested invoice. Uncontested invoice will match exactly with the Purchase Order issued by Procurement. Any changes made to the order must be reflected in a revised Invoice and or credit from the vendor and must match the revised Purchase Order. Payments shall be made consistent with Chapter 2251, Texas Government Code. Any orders identified as TPFA (Texas Public Finance Authority) are paid by TPFA on behalf of TSTC. TPFA will not prepay or make down payments for any orders placed by TSTC.

Any invoice that does not comply with the minimum requirements stated above may not be considered valid and may be subject to rejection and/or return to the contractor.

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Purpose with Minimum Requirments:

The (upper) high temperature chamber (2250°F) rated chamber is intended for hardening metal. The walls, roof, door and floor are each insulated with 2 ½ inches of thermally efficient insulated firebrick backed up by 1900°F rated board insulation. The hearth space in the upper hardening chamber is 12 inches wide by 20 inch deep, and the chamber has a 12 inch height. The upper chamber door opens vertically by rising. The temperature and inert gas introduction will be automatically controlled by a West 6700 programmable temperature controller with a separate type "K" thermocouple for each chamber. A Honeywell eZend digital recorder with three channel will provide process data.

The lower temperature, tempering chamber with alloy fan for re-circulation (1250°F rated) is intended for annealing and drawing heat treated metal parts. The lower chamber door is hinged and swings open to the side. The lower chamber with the fan recirculation fan measures 12 inches wide by 17 inches deep, and the chamber has a 12 inch height. The circulation of the atmosphere is produced by a 500 CFM capacity alloy fan that is belt driven by a ¼ H.P. motor. The fan creates a high rate of circulation and temperature uniformity within the chamber.

A Honeywell eZend digital recorder with three channel will provide process data. Below the two heat treating chambers is an optional quench tank that may be used for quenching and hardening metal parts.

The frame of the furnace is constructed of heavy gage steel (3/6) minimum.

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

### ITEMS BELOW APPLY TO AND BECOME A PART OF TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF BID, ANY EXCEPTIONS THERE TO MUST BE IN WRITING.

### A. BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

- Bidder must comply with all rules, regulations and statutes relating to purchasing in the State of Texas in addition to the requirements of this form.
- Bidders must price per unit shown. Unit prices shall govern in the event of extensionerrors.
- Bid should be submitted on this form. Bid must be time stamped at ordering agency on or before the hour and date specified for the Bid opening.
- Late and/or unsigned bids will not be considered under any circumstances. Person signing bid must have the authority to bind the firm in a contract.
- 5. Bid prices are requested to be firm for TSTC acceptance for 30 days from bid opening date. "Discount from list" bids are not acceptable unless requested. Cash discounts are not considered in determining an award. Cash discounts offered wil be taken if earned.
- 6. Bid should give Payee ID Number, full firm name and address of proposer on the face of this form. Enter in the space provided, if not shown. Additionally, firm name should appear on each continuation page of a bid, in the block provided in the upper right hand corner. The Payee ID Number is the taxpayer number assigned and used by the Comptroller of Public Accounts of Texas. If this number is not known, complete the following:

### B. TIE BIDS

Awards will be made in accordance with Rule \$20.36(b)(3) in Title 34 of the Texas Administrative Code and Rule \$20.38 (preferences).

#### C. AWARD OF CONTRACT

A response to this IFB is an offer to contract based upon the terms, conditions and specifications contained herein. Bids do not become contracts until they are accepted through an open market purchase order. The contract shall be governed, construed and interpreted under the laws of the State of Texas. The factors listed in Texas Government Code, Title 10, Subtitle D, Section 2155.074, 2155.144, 2156.007, and 2157.003 shall ako be considered in making an award. Any legal actions must be filed in McLennan County, Texas.

### D. PAYMENT

Vendor shallsubmit an itemized invoice showing TSTC's purchase order number. TSTC will incur no penalty for late payment if payment is made in 30 or fewer days from receipt of goods or services and an uncontested invoice.

### E. PATENTS OR COPYRIGHTS

The vendor agrees to protect TSTC from claims involving infringement of patents or copyrights.

### F. VENDOR ASSIGNMENTS

Vendor hereby assigns to ordering agency any and all claims for overcharges associated with this contract arising under the antitrust laws of the United States 15 U.S.C.A. Section 1, et seq. (1973), and the antitrust laws of the State of Texas, TEX. Bus. & Comm. Code Ann. Sec. 15.01, et seq. (1967). Inquiries pertaining to IFBs must give the requisition number, codes, and opening date.

### G. BIDDER AFFIRMATION

Neither the proposer nor the firm, corporation, partnership, or institution represented by the proposer, or anyone acting for such firm, corporation or institution has violated the antitrust laws of this State or the Federal Antitrust Laws, nor communicated directly or indirectly the bid made to any competitor or any other person engaged in such line of business.
- Pursuant to Section 2155.004 Government Code the proposer has not received compensation for participation in the preparation of the specifications for this bid.

Pursuant to Section 231.006(d), Family Code (relating to child support), the proposer certifies that the individual or business entity named in this bid is not in ineligible to receive this specified payment and acknowledges that this contract may be terminated and payment may be withheld if this certification is inaccurate.
- 5. Under Section 2155.004 Government Code the proposer certifies that the individual or business entity named in this bid is not ineligible to receive the specified contract and acknowledges that this contract may be terminated and/or payment withheld if this certification is inaccurate.
- 6. The Contractor shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless TSTC, all of its officers, agents and employees from and against all claims, actions, suits, demands, proceedings, costs, damages, and liabilities, arising out of, connected with, or resulting from any acts or commissions of contractor or any agent, employee, subcontractor, or supplier of contractor in the execution or performance of this contract.

Under §2155.004, Gov't Code, the bidder certifies that the individual or business entity named in this bid or any contract resulting from this IFB is not ineligible to receive the specified contract and acknowledges that the contract may be terminated and payment withheld if this certification is inaccurate. §2155.004 prohibits a person or entity from receiving a state contract if they received compensation for participating in preparing the solicitation or specifications for the contract.

### I. TEXAS PUBLIC INFORMATION ACT:

Notwithstanding any provisions of this IFB to the contrary, bidder understands that TSTC will comply with the Texas Public Information Act (Chapter 552, Gov't Code) as interpreted by judicial opinions and opinions of the Attorney General of the State of Texas. Information, documentation, and other material in connection with this solicitation or any resulting contract may be subject to public disclosure pursuant to the Texas Public Information Act. Any part of the solicitation response that is of a confidential or proprietary nature must be clearly and prominently marked as such by the bidder.

### J. CONFLICT OF INTEREST:

Under §2155.003, Gov't Code, a TSTC employee may not have an interest in, or in any manner be connected with a contract or bid for a purchase of goods or services by an agency of the state; or in any manner, including by rebate or gift, accept or receive from a person to whom a contract may be awarded, directly or indirectly, anything of value or a promise, obligation, or contract for future reward or compensation.
