The following information becomes a permanent part of the RFP:

**Question #1: Who is the training for? And what is the size of that group?**

A: The training would be for employees of companies that our Workforce Development offices develop training projects for. All of our offices around the state would be using the vendors that are approved under this RFP. The training would be "as needed". In terms of size, that will also vary. Typically, class sizes must be at minimum 5 trainees. Class sizes are usually capped by either the trainer/vendor or by the company itself.

**Question #2: Are there any specific areas (topics) that you are trying to train?**

A: Topics that we are trying to train are listed in the RFP under Appendix A – Training Capabilities Summary

**Question #3: My company is a cyber security company. One of our core offerings is employee training. We'd like to provide this service under this contract. Is this service part of the training that you require?**
